Further to your recent notification that revised drawings had been submitted in connection with the above application I am writing to confirm that we wish our original objections to still stand as we do not consider the applicant has made sufficient changes to overcome the overriding objection on safety grounds.

The revised drawings combined with the misleading representation of the size of boats to be moored at the pontoon extension do not comply with the requirement to maintain a safe 29 metre wide navigable channel.

It is disappointing there has been insufficient amendments to satisfy the safety concerns we and others have raised.

Also surprised by some of the comments in the new supporting statement with regard to the objections being 'brewed up'. This is simply not the case in our instance as over the years we have carefully monitored mooring developments/planning applications in the River Leven at Balloch. We are generally supportive of mooring facilities by local clubs but on the basis they do not compromise the safe passage of other boats including Sweeney's passenger fleet of cruise vessels.
